**Urban League Hosts Free Homebuyer Education Workshop**

**OKLAHOMA CITY – July 27, 2010** – The Urban League of Greater Oklahoma City, Inc. will host a free homebuyer education workshop, Saturday, July 31, 9 a.m. until 5 p.m., at the Urban League, 3900 N. Martin Luther King.

Taught by real estate and mortgage professionals, the workshop covers money management, credit issues, mortgages, budgeting, home maintenance, loan processes, closing procedures, and avoiding foreclosures. Participant will also learn eligibility requirements to receive a certificate that qualifies for down payment assistance.

Other topics covered during the workshop include: mortgage lending: sources of money and types of loans; knowing and understanding your credit as a homebuyer; and how much cash should be available to close the deal.

Admission is free and open to the public. Lunch will also be provided, free of charge. **However, space is limited, so reservations are required.**
